1. ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN DERMAL AESTHETICS (NQF Level 7, 120 credits, SAQA ID 97898)

The **Advanced Diploma in Dermal Aesthetics** is a distance learning programme, enabling you to continue your employment while completing your qualification. To support you in acquiring the necessary advanced skills, the programme will include various learning opportunities:

- **Contact sessions** through an interactive online platform. Students take part in the session either via live streaming or on-site at any one of the two campuses. Sessions will be presented one evening a week from 18:00 – 20:00 after which it will be uploaded to an online student platform where you can access the lesson at a later stage if you were unable to attend the session or require a repeat session.
- **Practical block contact sessions** will be hosted at the Stellenbosch and Pretoria campuses. It is compulsory for you to attend 3 block sessions per year. The duration is usually one week per block session (Monday – Friday).
- **Independent study** with the aid of study guides and carefully developed assignments/class tests to guide you through the course content and prepare you for the summative examinations at the end of your studies.
- Minimum duration for completion of this programme is 1 year (Full time) and maximum duration for completion of studies is 2 years (Part time).

Should you choose the Part Time study option, you will complete your studies over 2 years, with compulsory subjects and modules set out below:

- ◆ *1st Year compulsory subjects : Advanced Procedures (Semester 1); Practice Management (Semester 1 and 2) and Modules 1, 2 & 3 (Semester1)*

3. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A three-year Diploma in Somatology (NQF Level 6, 360 credits) **or** equivalent qualification in a cognate field; and
- Recognition of prior learning: Students must provide evidence of prior learning for which they may receive credit towards the qualification. Evidence must be presented in the form of portfolios of evidence or any other form of appropriate evidence which may include verified accounts of previous relevant work experience.

NOTE:

Entry into the Advanced Diploma in Dermal Aesthetics is not automatic. A limited number of students can be accepted and selection will be based on academic performance and/or work experience.

4. HOW TO APPLY

Please complete an application form from our website. The closing date of applications is end September 2020 and successful candidates will be informed during the month of October of the outcome of their application, whereby a non-refundable Registration/Administration fee is required to secure your place at the Academy.

Should we not receive your non-refundable Registration/Administration fee within 2 weeks after receiving the outcome of your application, you will automatically be placed on the waiting list and entry into the programme cannot be guaranteed.

4.1 **Type of Applicant:** Please choose carefully as we cannot change your study option once you applied.

- a) **Full time student**, defined as a student that will complete their studies in 1-Year, or
- b) **Part time student**, defined as a student that will complete his/her studies over 2-years.

All applicants will be required to submit the following supporting documents to complete their application.

Without these supporting documents we cannot process your application:

- A certified copy of your ID document or passport;
- A certified copy of your Grade 12/or equivalent results;
- A certified copy of your tertiary qualifications obtained/in progress;
- Detailed CV with work experience (compulsory for applicants with work experience); and
- Study permit (for non-SA Resident students) on or before Registration.
